At completion, this project will have invested between \$14-\$14.5 million into the Northeast Fort Wayne quadrant's infrastructure, enhanced pedestrian safety, improved the traffic flow and incorporated energy saving LED technology.

The city will be present at April's general meeting to give you another opportunity to see the plans and ask your questions.

In the August-September 2016 timeframe, the city will begin contacting adjacent property owners for the right of way acquisitions and settlements. This will impact the signage at the 4 entrances on Maplecrest. In 2018 the construction phase will begin; the plan is to maintain 2 way traffic at all times. Anticipated to last 2 full construction seasons, here is the order of the project: West side State to Trier; East side State to Trier; West side Trier to Stellhorn; East side Trier to Stellhorn and the last section Stellhorn/ Maplecrest intersection.
