Annual Dues

October 31st is the deadline to pay your homeowners association dues for the upcoming year. Your dues help pay to keep the streets in our neighborhood plowed, maintain entrances, social events, legal fees, and other costs for our neighborhood. Paying your dues on time will prevent late fees. Extended non-payment will lead to professional collection efforts and may include having a lien placed on your property. Please be sure to pay your dues on time.

How to Pay:

This year we are offering multiple payment options including online bill pay through your financial institution, check/money order by mail, and online payment via Cheddar Up.

Fall Leaf Pick-Up is right around the corner. Please remember leaves should be placed at the edge of your front yard but NOT in the street. This direction is a city law not an association rule, we must comply with the city laws. Also, be extra watchful for children when driving past piles of leaves.

Architectural Control Committee

All construction, repair, replacement, structure installation, or improvement of any type must have approval from the ACC. Items required for approval include, primary home, shed, driveway and fence. New Project-Message Boards

Our association is a recipient of the 2022 Neighborhood Improvement Grant program. We received \$5,000 of funding to go toward message boards at all of our entrances! These message boards will provide our neighbors with important information about the association throughout the year. Message boards should be installed before the end of the year. A big thank you to Mike Barrett, Association President for submitting for this grant!

Mailbox Project Update and Treasurer's Report:

The association is offering neighbors free, brand new mailboxes at no cost to you as a homeowner! 138 homes in our association have received their new mailbox. 39 homes are in process of being completed. All neighbors sharing a mailbox post need to agree to receive new mailboxes. Mailboxes will go in the same place with the same number of boxes together as currently stands. The association will need a signature from each of the homeowners on the mailbox post in order to put in the new mailboxes.
